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

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

For the following question, by "medical companies", we mean companies such as drug companies, companies making medical products etc. Please read the following statement before answering the following question... The Great North Care Record wants to find out what people think about agreeing to share the information in their healthcare record with medical companies for research and development of new products and services, which could help wider society. This might mean that these companies could look at your identifiable information, but they could only use your information for the uses you've agreed to. By identifiable, we mean that your name, address and medical history would be seen by the medical company. After seeing the previous video and reading the above, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? I would share my identifiable healthcare record with medical companies if it contributed to the development of better products or services.



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
