Great North Care Record: What's included?

Introduction

Great North Care Record is a shared health and social care record in the North East and North Cumbria region. Across the region different organisations share a different set of information. This is due to various factors including:

- The digital maturity of the organisation
- The type of record system they use
- Internal information governance considerations
- Internal clinical safety considerations
- National record sharing guidelines

This guide is intended to give an overview of the items being shared. Within each organisation the full data set is complex and may have exclusions applied. If you require a more detailed breakdown, please contact the GNCR team on nuth.gncr@nhs.net.

For some organisations, data is returned in structured pieces and is split up into the various dedicated widgets in the record. For other organisations data is returned in a single report and will display in one widget in the record. The location of the data for each organisation is also indicated in this guide.

If the information is not available do not assume it does not exist, follow your usual processes to request from the organisation directly.

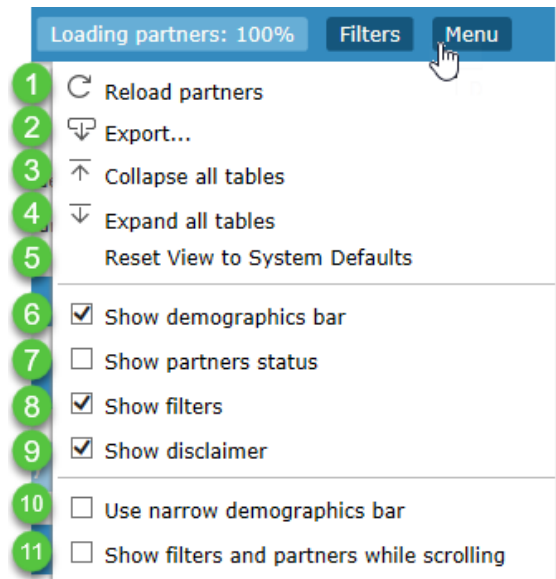

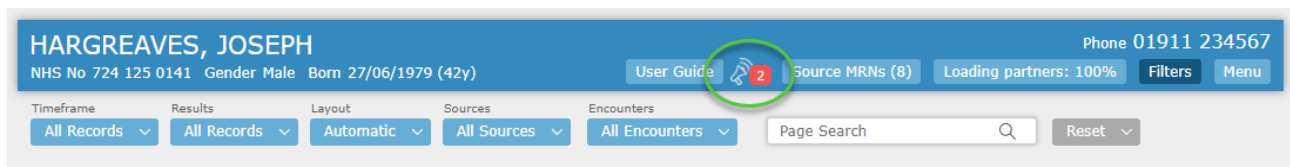
Scenario

This guide shows how to use the News and updates button in the Great North Care Record. This feature allows the Great North Care Record team to communicate important updates to users, such as:

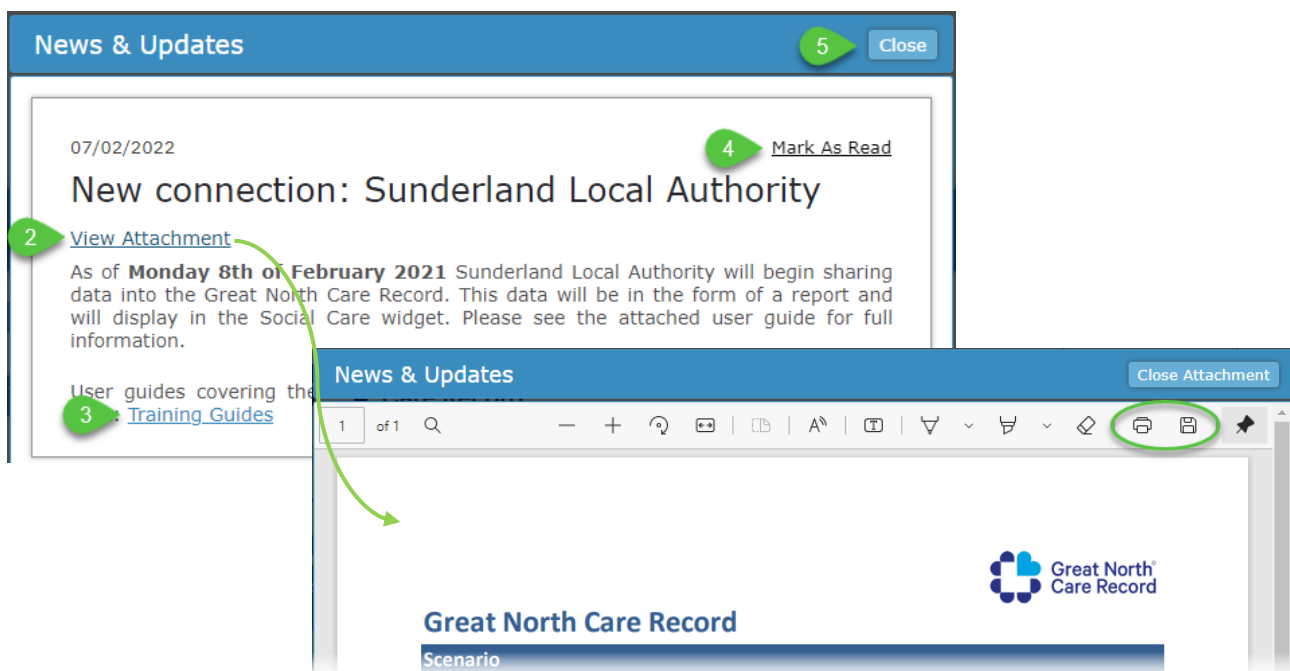
- New organisations sharing data

- Notifications of performance or connectivity issues

News and updates

1. Access the News and updates feed by selecting the **loudspeaker icon** in the demographics bar. A visual counter will display when there are new messages.



2. When selected the news feed will display. If the message has an attachment the **View Attachment** link will display. When selected the attachment will open and can be printed or downloaded.
3. The message can include **hyperlinks**. When selected the website will open in a new window.
4. To mark the message as read select **Mark As Read**.
5. To close the news feed select **Close**.




Timeframe/Timeline

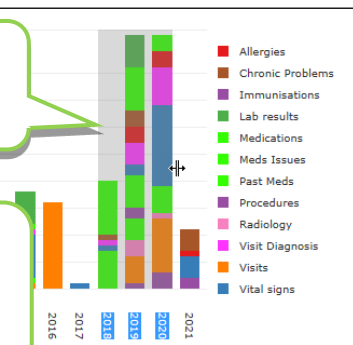

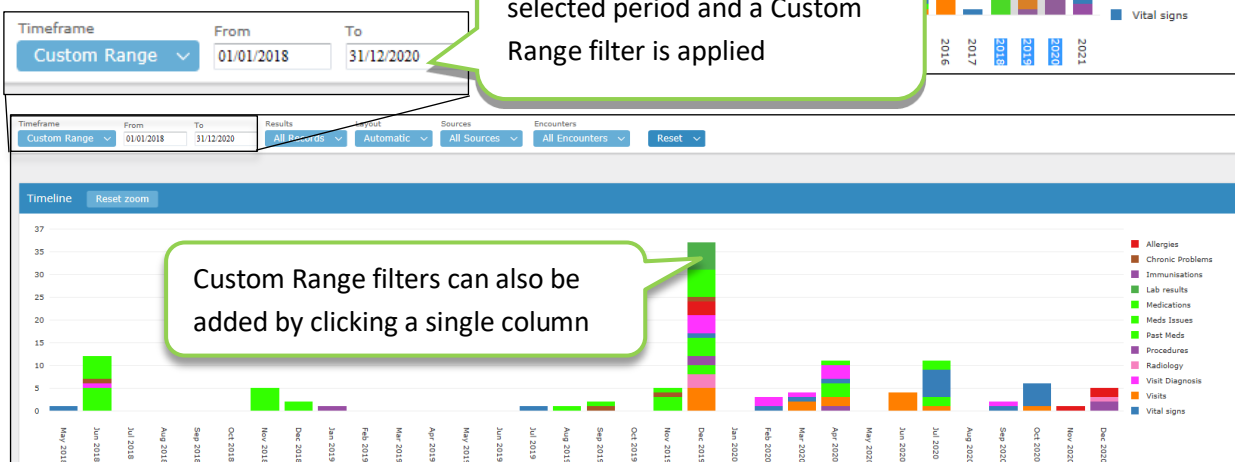

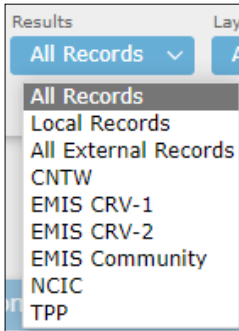

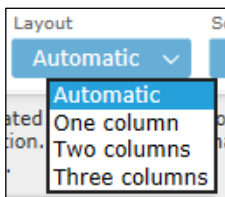

Results from on demand connection are listed separately or you can filter on local or external records.

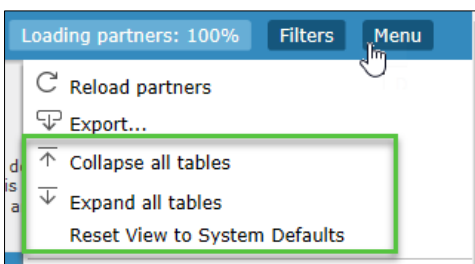

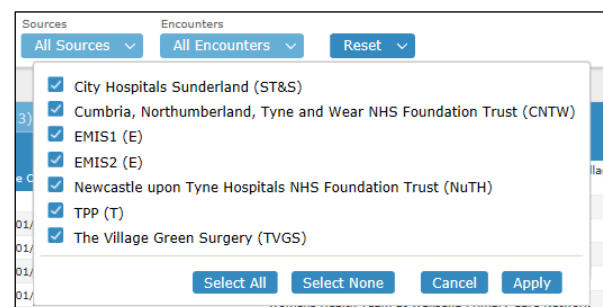

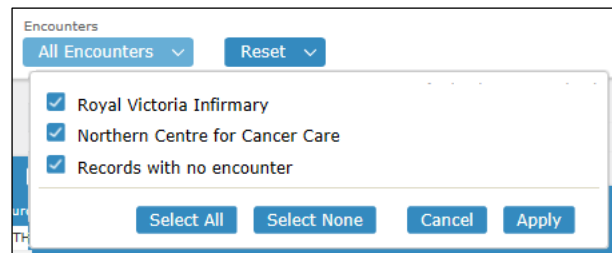

Search

Use the Search function to look for specific terms within the record.

Tick the 'Search also in reports' to also search in the report sections such as GP Records, Mental Health, Community. If the term is found the result will be highlighted in yellow and the number at the top of the widget will show the number of results.

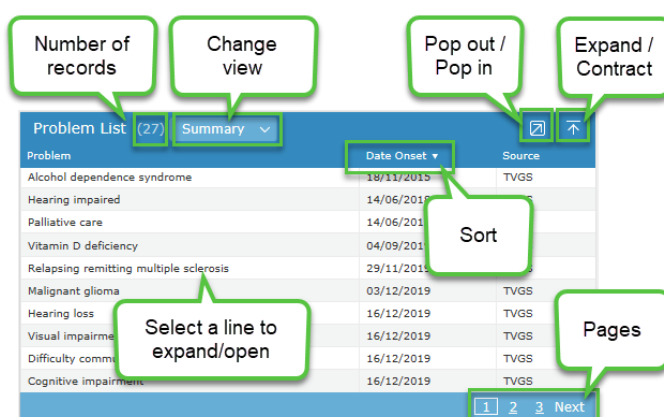

- If there are multiple pages, click the 'Pop out' button to view the information all in one page
- The 'Summary' view works best in the standard smaller widget – click a line to view the details
- The 'Details' view works best when the section is 'Popped out'



Reports

Report sections display blue hyperlinks in the widget. Click the hyperlink to open the report.

The following sections are reports: GP Records, Additional GP Records, Social Care, Mental Health, Community, Miscellaneous Reports, Radiology, Cellular Pathology.

Lab results and Vital signs also display as a report if the 'Results Sets/Orders' view is chosen.

- When a report is open, you can easily move to the next one in the list by using the arrows

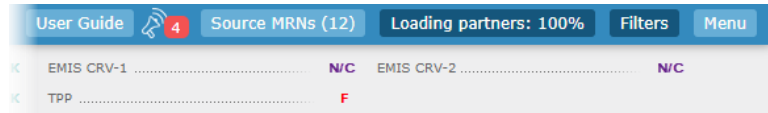

- F = connection to partner failed

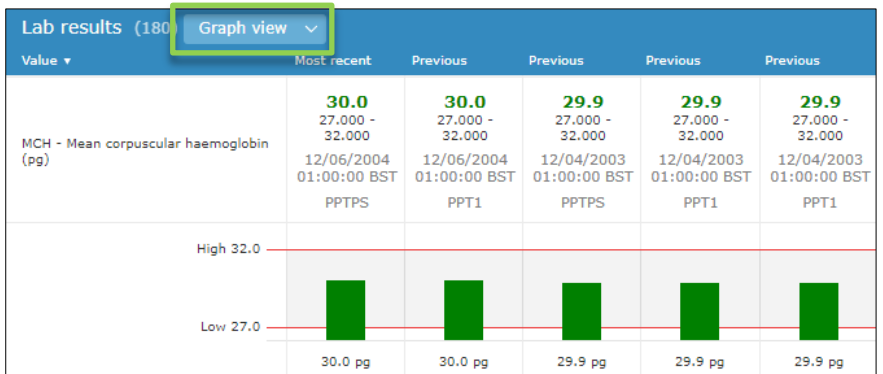
