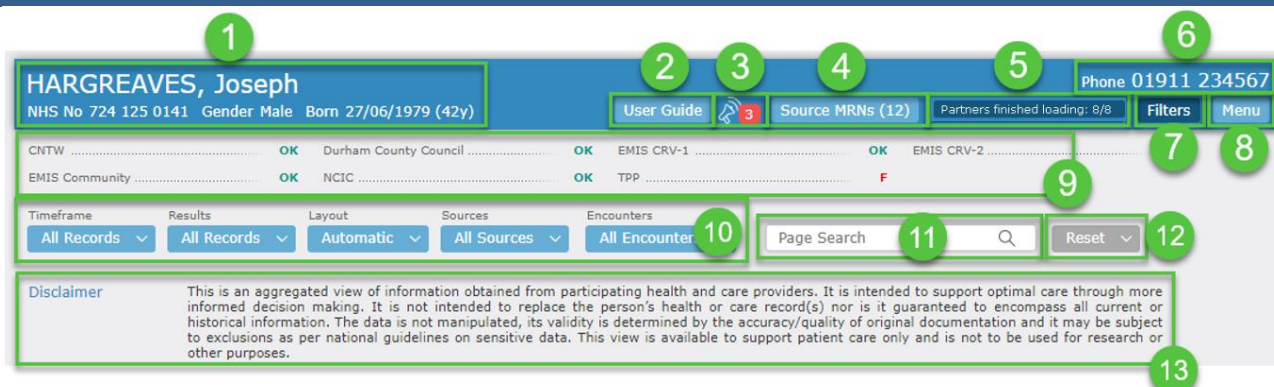


Great North Care Record: Demographics and menus

Header

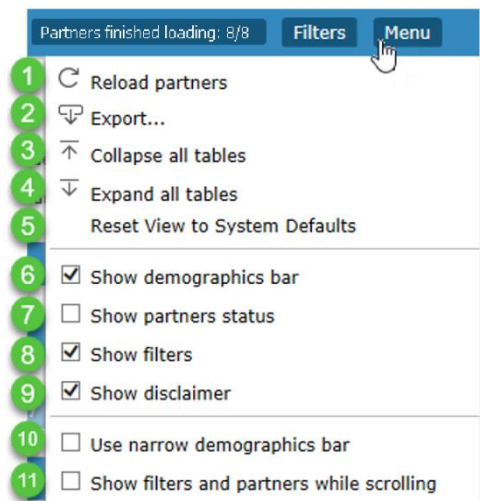

Menu

1. Reload on demand connection partners
2. *Admin only function*
3. Collapse all sections
4. Expand all sections
5. Reset view to System Default – will collapse all sections and move them into default order
6. Show/hide demographics bar (*blue bar at top*)
7. Show/hide partner status bar
8. Show/hide filter bar
9. Show/hide disclaimer
10. Switch to narrow demographics bar
11. Demographics bar, partner bar and filter bar remain visible when scrolling



Source MRNs

1. Organisations unique identifier, also known as hospital number or client ID
2. Organisation name
3. Number of items shared by this organisation into the Great North Care Record
4. Patient name, gender and first line of address
5. Hover over a line to see additional details include the address held by the organisation
