The distinction between GP providers using EMIS and GP providers using SystmOne is highlighted.


## Medications – GP using EMIS

If the GP is using **EMIS** the **Medications** section will be populated. Active medications will be displayed in this section.

Medications prescribed by a hospital or other provider will only display here if the GP has added them into the GP Record.

When you click on a row it will provide further information next to 'Details'.

Medications provided by other services might not be recorded in GNCR.

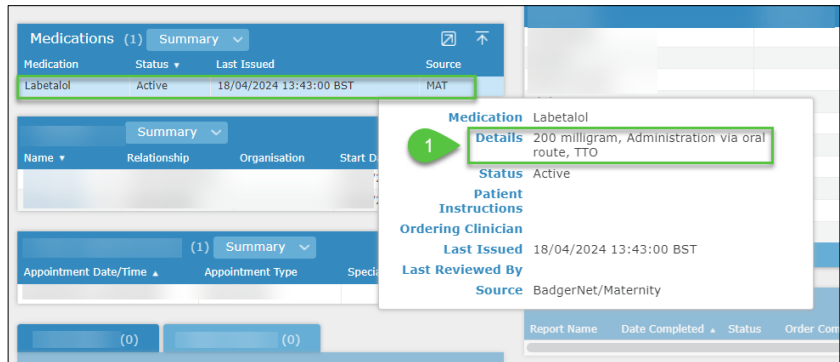
